Nominations are put forward by the Provincial Office Staff, who may (but do not have to) solicit the advisement or suggestion of SOS members. The Chair of the Special Olympics Saskatchewan Board of Directors will carefully review the nominations and select the recipient no later than two weeks prior to the Awards Ceremony.

Award Criteria:

The prestigious Bob Pedde Memorial Award is awarded to an individual who has shown outstanding dedication and contributions to Special Olympics Saskatchewan. This award is in honor of the memory of Bob Pedde, whose dedication to the Special Olympic(s) movement is legendary. Nominations will be judged on the strength and quality of their submission by the Chair.

Award Recognition:

- This award will be presented to the successful recipient at the Provincial Awards Banquet held annually.
- The recipients' names will be added to Special Olympics Saskatchewan memorial plaque.
- The recipient will receive a take-home plaque/award.
- The recipient will be recognized in the Special Olympics Saskatchewan newsletter.
- This individual will be further considered for the National Jim Thompson award
